



NOTICE of PUBLIC HEARING NH 101A WIDENING PROJECT

The Special Committee in accordance with RSA 230 and RSA 231 with special emphasis on RSA 230:45 and RSA 231:5 and the Surface Transportation and Uniform Relocation Assistance Act of 1987, have set a public hearing thereon to be held in Room 150, at the Nashua Community College, 505 Amherst Street, Nashua NH 03063 on **Monday, August 18, 2008 at 7:00 pm.**

THE AUDITORIUM WILL BE OPEN ONE-HALF (1/2) HOUR PRIOR TO THE TIME OF HEARING FOR THE INSPECTION OF PLANS BY ANY INTERESTED PERSONS.

We, the undersigned Special Committee, appointed by Governor and Council on April 9, 2008 hereby give written Notice to said Petitioner and the owners of land over which said highway may pass; and to all others interested by posting a like copy in at least two (2) public places in the City of Nashua, and leaving a like copy with the City Clerk and Tax Collector of the said City of Nashua at least fourteen (14) days before the said day of hearing.

Relocation assistance will be furnished each owner or tenant whose improvements or business will be taken for this project, prior to negotiations for the property. The assistance shall include a list of other available property or rents in the area. Interested landowners, local officials and highway users are welcome and will be given the opportunity to express their feelings relative to the location. The testimony will be recorded.

This project will impact approximately 68 parcels along NH 101A. No relocations are required. The property impacts are necessitated due to roadway widening, sidewalk construction, and utility relocations. Nine of the 68 parcels require only easements for grading and driveway reconstruction.

Maps, plans, the environmental studies and other pertinent information developed by the City, along with written views received as result of the coordination with other agencies will be for review on or **after July 15, 2008** at the offices of the Nashua Regional Planning Commission located at 115 Main Street, Nashua NH 03061, or at the following website:

Written statements and other exhibits may be submitted to the Nashua Regional Planning Commission, c/o Camille Pattison, at 115 Main Street, P.O. Box 847, Nashua, NH 03061 up to (10) days after the date of the hearing for inclusion in the official record.

- This project is tentatively scheduled for advertising for bid in 2011 and construction to begin in 2012, with right-of-way acquisitions to be initiated in late 2009, and continuing through completion of the project.
