



NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

NASHUA – 10136A NH 101A - RECONSTRUCTION:

The project will widen NH 101A to 3 lanes in each direction from Somerset Parkway west to Celina Avenue in Nashua. The goal of this project is to increase vehicular capacity along the corridor while simultaneously enhancing pedestrian, bicycle, and public transit use. The widening project is currently in the preliminary engineering and design phase. During this phase preliminary drawings, environmental documentation and traffic reports have been produced. This phase will be followed by the development of final plans leading to construction. Construction is scheduled for 2012.

The Special Committee in accordance with RSA 230 and RSA 231 with special emphasis on RSA 230:45 and RSA 231:5 and the Surface Transportation and Uniform Relocation Assistance Act of 1987, will meet to determine if there is occasion for the layout of highway improvements as proposed for the NH 101 A Road Widening and Improvements Project in Nashua, NH at a public meeting to be held in Room 150, at the Nashua Community College, 505 Amherst Street, Nashua NH 03063 on **Tuesday, February 17, 2009 at 2:00 pm.**

This Special Committee Meeting is a public proceeding under RSA Chapter 91-A. The intent of this meeting is to serve as a decision making forum for the Special Committee. The public may observe the proceedings, however no public testimony will be taken.
