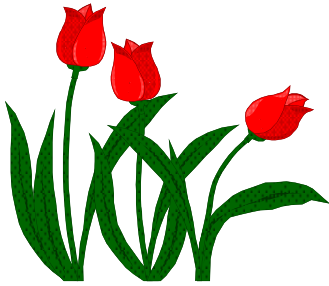

*Class 2 whitewater suitable for beginning canoeists and kayakers properly dressed for cold water. Wetsuit or drysuit and helmet required.*
