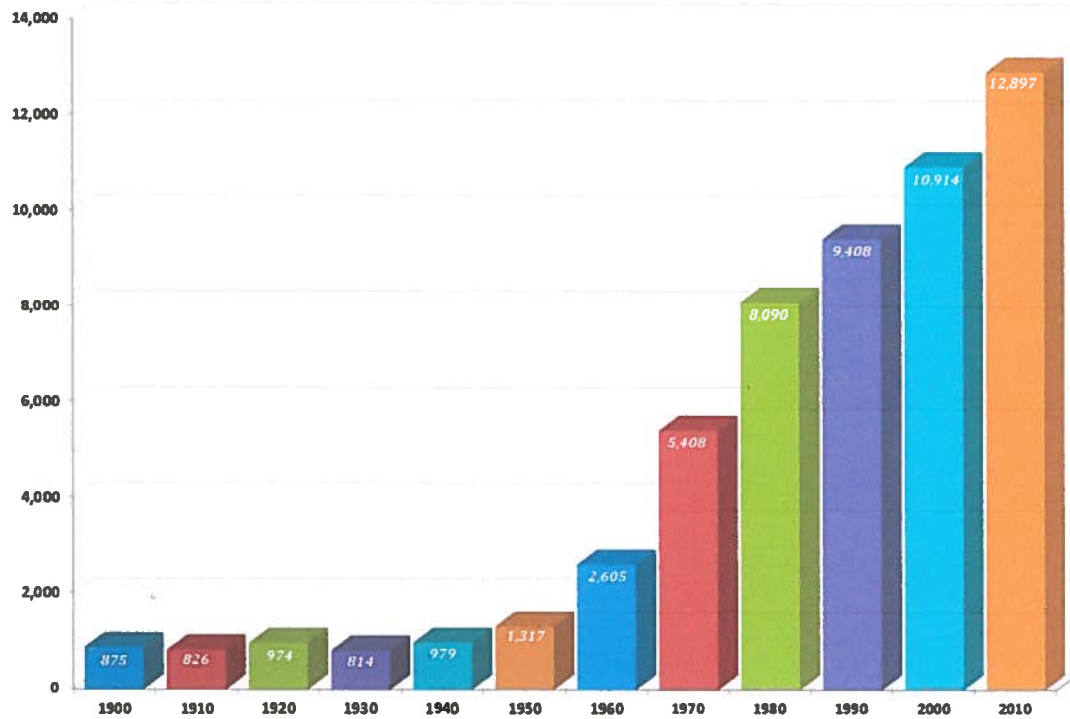

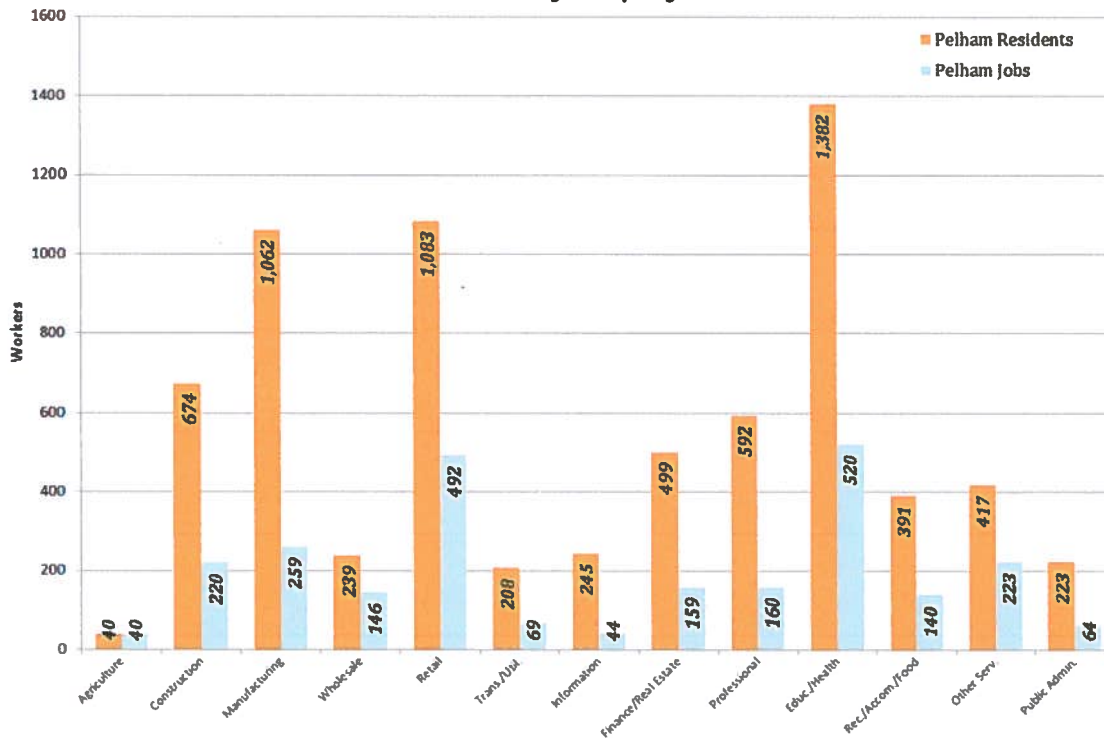


Pelham Profile
