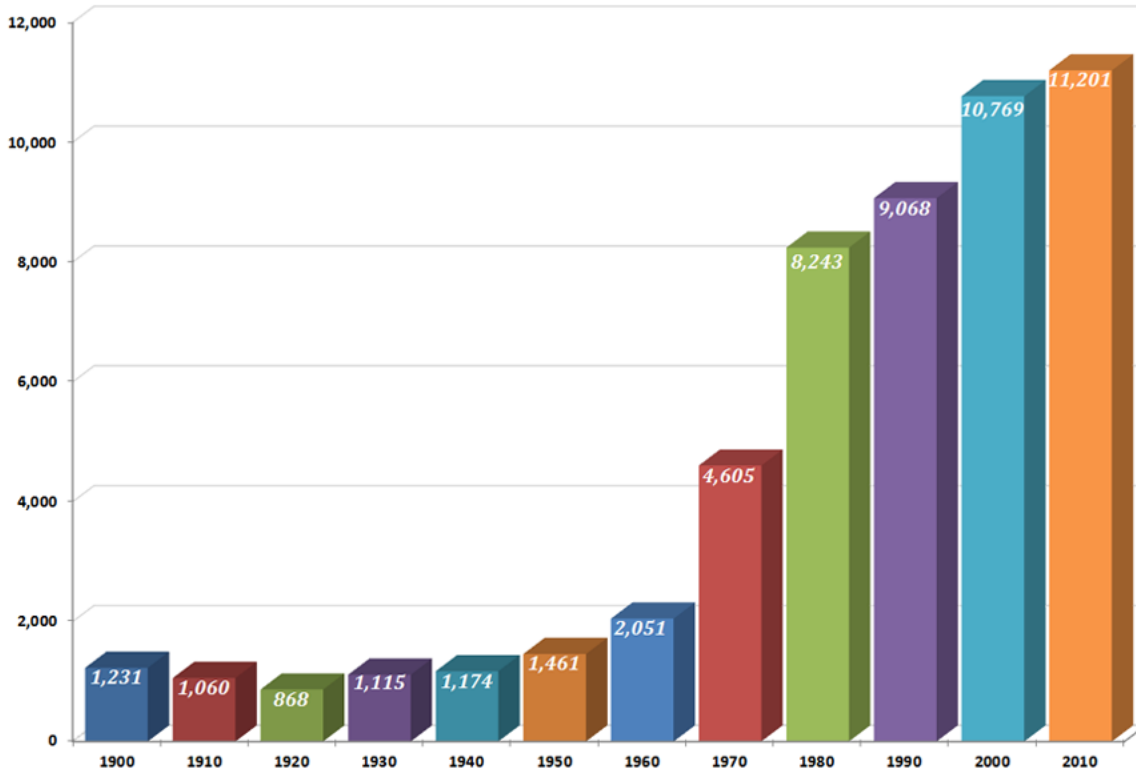

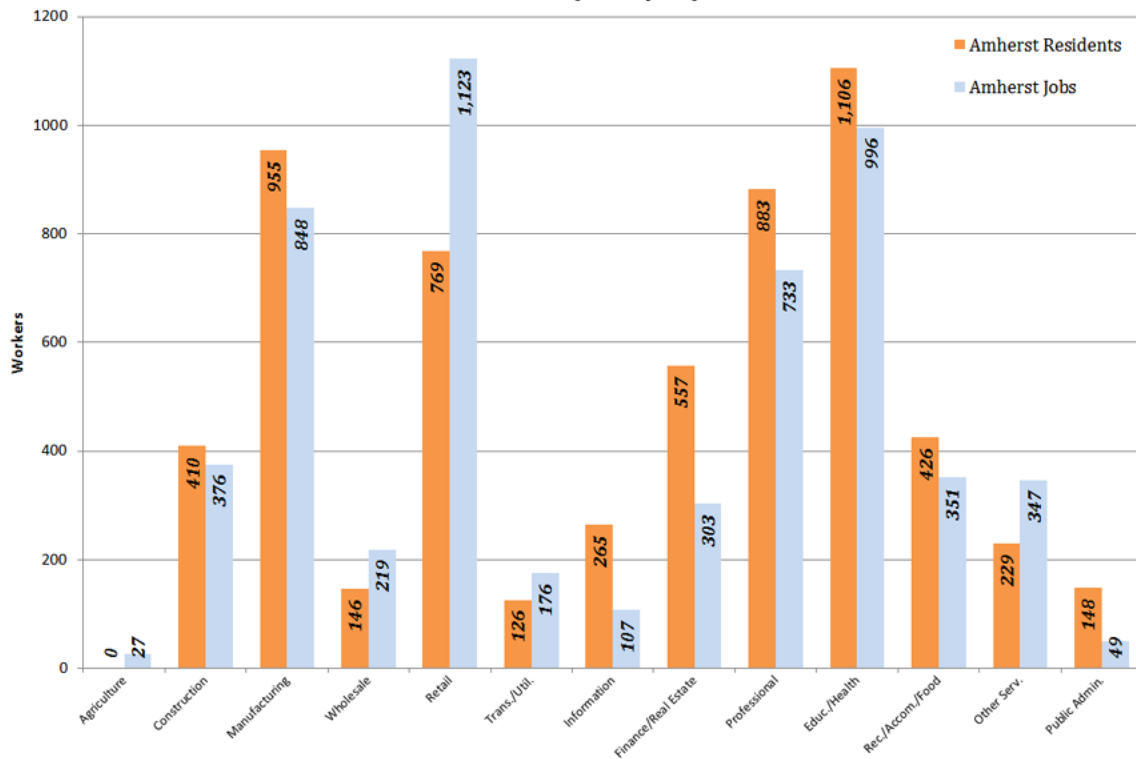


## Amherst Profile
