



EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

The Nashua Regional Planning Commission, established in 1959 to serve its member communities with comprehensive transportation, land use, mapping, data, and environmental planning services, seeks an Executive Director.

The Executive Director is a professional position with varied and complex administrative and managerial duties providing professional staff support to the Commission. Further, the Director performs skilled, specialized, professional activities on behalf of the Commission relating to the formulation of broad municipal land use policy; coordinates staff support for community long-range planning programs, data analysis and synthesis; oversees transportation planning activities; coordinates other initiatives on behalf of the Commission.

The Executive Director is appointed by a vote of the Full Board of Commissioners, and works under the broad supervision of the Executive Committee which outlines Commission policy and goals. The position requires comprehensive knowledge of the principles of planning, zoning, community and economic development, public administration and budgeting; experience in a technical discipline such as engineering, architecture, landscape architecture and municipal planning.

Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with specialization in planning, business, public administration, or a related field and a master's degree or equivalent is required. Candidates must have at least eight years of progressively responsible experience of an administrative, planning, or zoning nature in a public jurisdiction or a private organization, with at least five years of progressive management experience. The Executive Committee will consider any equivalent combination of education and experience.
