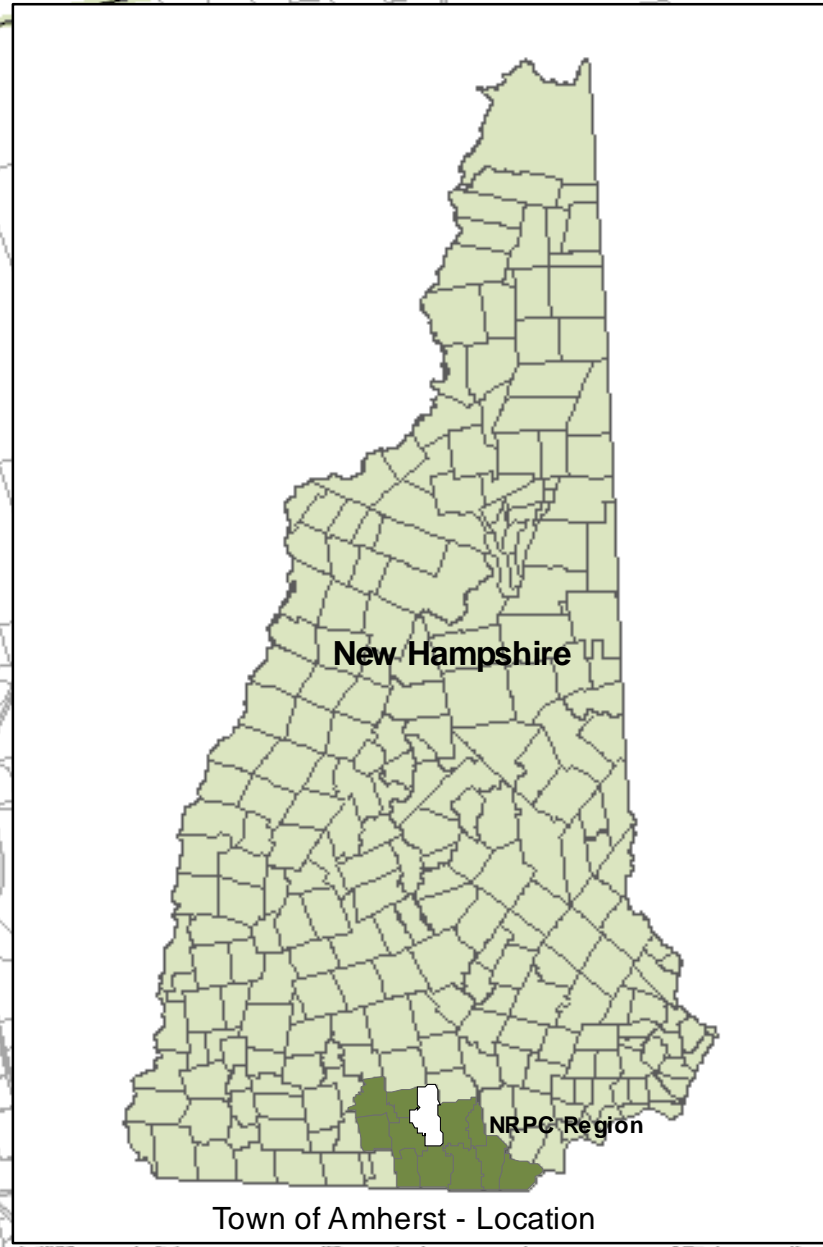


Town of Amherst, NH - Existing Land Use

MAP DATA SOURCES

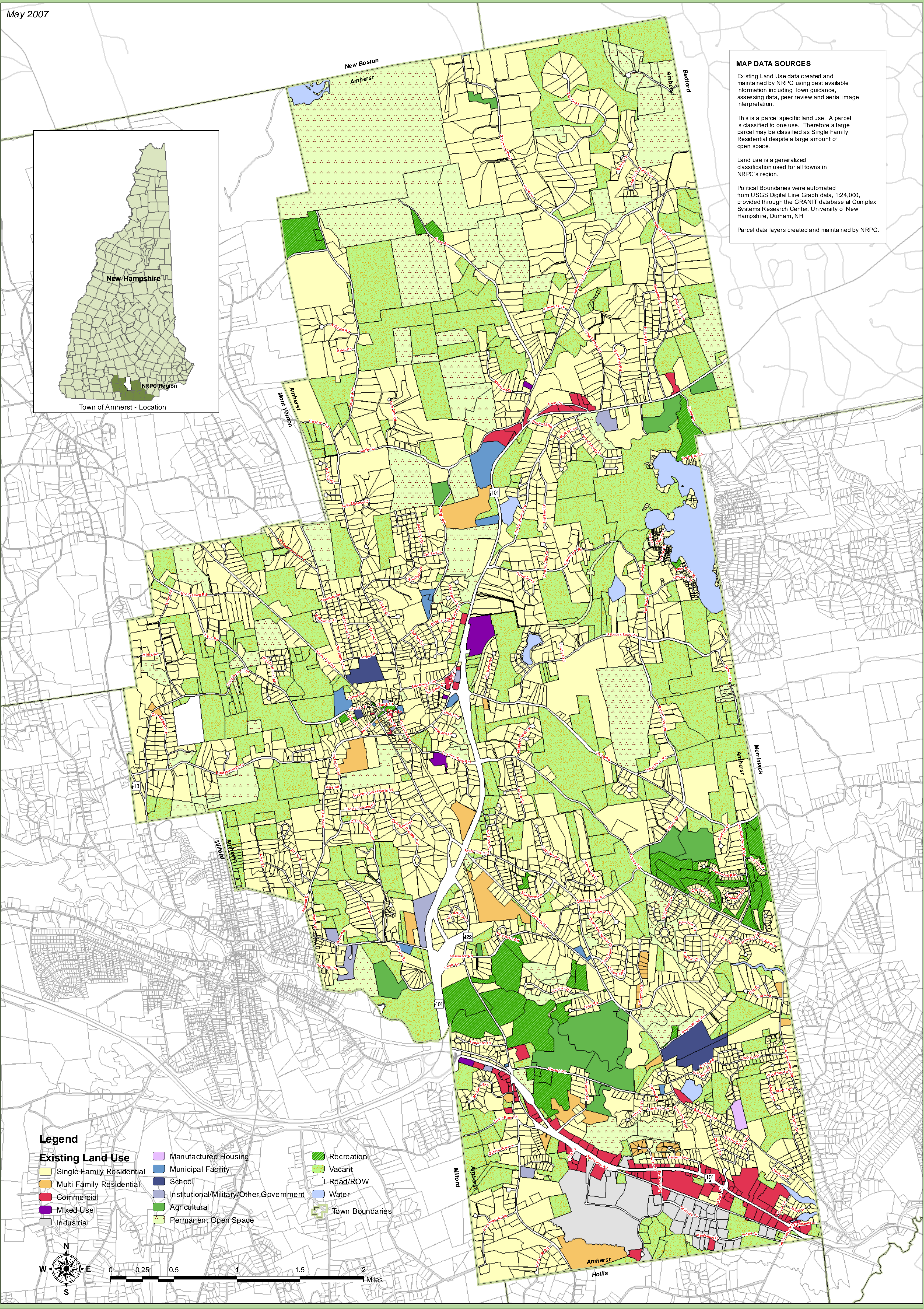
Existing Land Use data created and maintained by NRPC using best available information including Town guidance, assessing data, peer review and aerial image interpretation.

This is a parcel specific land use. A parcel is classified to one use. Therefore a large parcel may be classified as Single Family Residential despite a large amount of open space.

Land use is a generalized classification used for all towns in NRPC's region.

Political Boundaries were automated from USGS Digital Line Graph data, 1:24,000, provided through the GRANIT database at Complex Systems Research Center, University of New Hampshire, Durham, NH
