Next Steps

1. City Approval of Municipal Management Agreement
2. Environmental Reappraisal of Project Concept – The original FEIS dates from early 1998. The age of the document as well as the changes in project concept require the environmental reappraisal – time required: 12 months
 - a. Updated analysis of historical/cultural resources, neighborhood impacts, wetlands, etc.
 - b. Public Information Meeting(s)
 - c. Approval of Environmental Reappraisal by Resource Agencies and Federal Highway Administration
 - d. Selection of Final Concept by City
3. Final Design – time required: 18 to 24 months
4. Completion of Right-of-way Acquisition – occurs concurrent with Final Design, time required: 12 to 18 months
5. Construction – multiple contracts, time required 24 months to point where roadway is open, 36 months to completion of grading, landscaping, etc.
