Gathering Input

Shortly thereafter, project leaders will hold a Town-wide Community Visioning Meeting to gather input from citizens and begin forming the Town's Vision. For those who can't attend the meeting, opportunities to provide input will continue for several weeks.

Once a broad spectrum of input has been gathered, interested citizens will delve further into selected topics using a "Study Circle" approach.

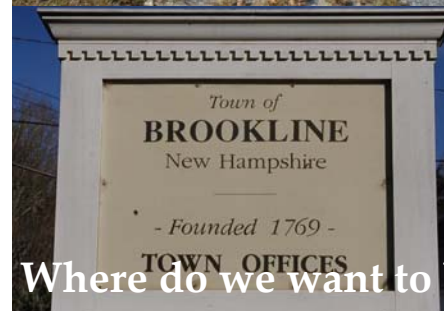

Visioning 101

What is Visioning?

Visioning is a process by which a community pictures the future it wants and plans how to achieve it. It focuses on a wide range of concerns and is strongly linked with community values. The Brookline Community Vision Plan will help the Town compile information that may be incorporated into the updated Vision Chapter of the Master Plan.

What are the Benefits of Visioning?

Visioning helps communities to:

1. better understand citizens' values and use them as a basis for planning
2. identify trends and forces that are affecting the community
3. articulate a big-picture view to guide short-term decisions and long-term initiatives
4. develop tools to achieve its vision

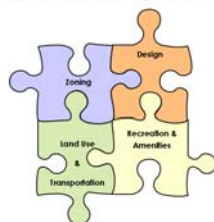
What issues will be addressed in Brookline's Vision?
