COMMENT PERIOD AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT PROCESS**

The Nashua Regional Planning Commission (NRPC) announces, as required by Federal regulations, that it will start accepting public comments for the updated Public Involvement Process (PIP) for Transportation Planning beginning on Friday, April 26th, 2019 and closing the comment period on Monday, June 10th, 2019. NRPC is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the City of Nashua and Towns of Amherst, Brookline, Hollis, Hudson, Litchfield, Lyndeborough, Merrimack, Milford, Mont Vernon, Pelham and Wilton, NH. The full PIP document will be available at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, April 26th, 2019 via the NRPC website (www.nashuarpc.org).

The PIP document will be discussed at the Wednesday, May 8th, 2019 Transportation Technical Advisory Committee (TTAC) meeting. A public hearing for the PIP document has been scheduled for Wednesday, June 19th, 2019 at 7 p.m. at the NRPC office located on 30 Temple Street, Suite 310, Nashua, NH 03060.

Interested parties are invited to review, suggest and submit comments on the PIP document during the comment period from April 26th, 2019 through June 10th, 2019, during the TTAC meeting on May 8th or at the public hearing on June 19th.
