

Regional Planner

[The Nashua Regional Planning Commission](#) (NRPC) seeks an experienced Planner to join its highly-functioning multi-disciplinary team. The ideal candidate will have a background in urban planning at the municipal or regional level, experience in staffing local land use boards and a familiarity with transportation and environmental planning. The regional planner will provide plan review services, ordinance development, Master Plan preparation and other similar services to NRPC communities on a contractual basis and work on a variety of other land use, transportation, economic development, and environmental projects as needed. Applicants should possess excellent verbal and written communication skills and be comfortable making public presentations. Working knowledge or familiarity with GIS, graphic design, or landscape architecture a plus.

Qualifications: A bachelors or master's degree in Urban Planning or a related discipline and at least three-to five years of relevant work experience. Applicants should be adept at working in a variety of software platforms including Microsoft Office Suite. Must have a valid driver's license at the time of appointment and be able to attend evening meetings. Some outdoor work may be required in areas of uneven terrain and wooded environs as well as in urban areas. Salary range \$40,000 to \$60,000 commensurate with experience and qualifications.
